LITTLE GIRAFFE™

The Giraffe chair was designed by Arne Jacobsen in 1959, specifically for the restaurant at the SAS Royal Hotel in Copenhagen. Its high back and padded armrests make for a cosy and comfortable seat. The Little Giraffe™ chair is an evolution of its iconic predecessor – a striking rendition suitable for hospitality, meeting rooms or dining spaces.

ABOUT THE DESIGNER

The collaboration between Arne Jacobsen and Fritz Hansen dates back to 1934. It was not until 1952 however that the team got its breakthrough with the Ant™. It was succeeded by Series 7™ in 1955, thereby enabling both Jacobsen and Fritz Hansen to write their names into furniture history.

3201: Fixed cover, 4 legs

3201R: Removable cover, 4 legs

3211: Fixed cover, height-adjustable, 5 castors

MATERIAL

Shell: The shell is made of a combination of molded hard and soft (MDI) polyurethane foam, reinforced with steel frame and with glass fiber enforcement edges. The chair comes with either a fixed or a removable cover.

Base: The four-legged base is made of bended steel tubes which are either chromed or powder coated. The star shaped base with castors is made of die-cast aluminium with a satin polished or powder coated finish. The base can be configured with either castors with aluminium housing (height adjustable with tilt mechanism) or black-grey plastic toes (fixed seat height with spring function). Glides, cover cap and castor rims are made of plastic.

The Little Giraffe™ is available in the following selection of textile and leather types:

Textile: Canvas, Capture, Christianshavn™, Comfort (only 3201/3211), Diablo, Divina, Divina Melange, Divina MD, Fame, Fiord, Hallingdal, Remix, Re-Wool, Steelcut, Steelcut Trio, Sunniva and Tonus.

Leather: Essential, Aura, Embrace, Essential, Grace, Natural and Rustik.

The Little Giraffe™ is upholstered without glue it gives both functional flexibility and visual versatility, whether you are looking to exchange the cover or simply remove it for cleaning.

MADE-TO-ORDER

Non-standard configurations (special colours, upholstery etc.) are available upon request at a minimum order quantity.

PRODUCTION PROCESS

Shell: The backrest is made from PUR-foam moulded around an inner steel frame. The seat is also made from PUR-foam moulded around a steel frame with nozag springs. The two pieces are upholstered individually and assembled.

Base: The steel base is made from bended and welded steel tubes and is available in either chromed steel or powder coated steel. Fritz Hansen uses both trivalent chromium (Cr3) and hexavalent chromium (Cr6) for chromium plating. Fritz Hansen will convert to solely using trivalent chromium (Cr3) when the capacity in the Industry allows it.

The chair is covered with a recycled plastic bag and shipped in a recycled cardboard box. All packaging material can be recycled.

REPAIR, DISPOSAL AND REUSE

In the case of disposal, the chair can be disassembled into two parts (shell and base). The shell requires special handling because of the embedded steel frame. After separating foam and steel, both items can be recycled. Check local regulations for recycling options and whether there is potential for reuse.

WARRANTY

Fritz Hansen provides a five-year warranty on standard products against defects in materials and workmanship. An extended warranty of up to twenty years is provided on selected products provided they have been registered online on fritzhanzen.com/my-fh.

Standard: 5 years (Lacquer on base, Height-adjustable, Swivel, Castors, Fabric, Leather: Essential)

Extended: 10 years (Base, Shell, Leather: Aura, Rustik, Natural, Grace, Embrace)

On any material, fabric or leather, which is not listed in our price list on a specific product, the standard warranty is 2 years.

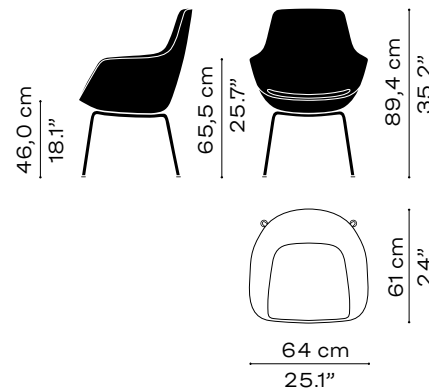
